"My inspiration to paint and draw people is constant. When I observe people - I am seeing a soft golden hue against the face, an expression of emotional involvement when playing the cello, the strong morning sunlight creating magical contours over a child's face - and I am compelled to capture that on canvas. To me, it is the intensity of that moment, the graceful body positions, the light, shadows, and colors that need to be rendered."

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# Pricing Guidelines

The following is a guideline that I apply to pricing my portraitures. The prices quoted are for a single person. Each additional person in the portrait increases the price by two-thirds.

Preliminary photo shoots are necessary for children especially, but also done for adults, as most people don't have the time to sit for the artist. However, I would encourage you to participate in the process and allow me to paint from life. It may take a series of 3 to 4 sittings at about 3 hours per session.

All of my portrait work is done on 100% linen canvas, primed with oil based primer. Your satisfaction is upper most in my mind & your participation in the process is welcome.
